Welcome to Year 3.

I will be your child's class teacher this year. Mrs Chamberlain will be the classroom support and Mr Rodger will continue taking our PE sessions.

Homework



Each week your child will receive homework via Edulink. Each week your child will receive spellings, times tables practice and tasks based on what they are doing in Literacy, Numeracy or Topic. The homework is to consolidate and reinforce basic skills, strategies, facts and rules. Unfortunately, at this time, we cannot have any homework returned but we will review the tasks with the children. If your child is struggling to complete their homework, please ask for help.

Also, read regularly with your child and learn spellings (we now have daily spelling sessions where your child will take part in a range of spelling activities and the test will take place on a Friday).

You could help by discussing the book with your child, asking questions about the characters and story as well as predicting parts of the story.

We will be meeting with you in person before the October half term. This will be an opportunity for us to let you know how your child has settled into their new class. Dates and times will follow shortly.

PE

Our PE day is Monday so please ensure your child comes to school in their full PE kit including trainers.

Please remember to label all items of PE kit as well as their uniform.

School Uniform

Please ensure that your child is wearing the full school uniform, which consists of a white shirt (available from any store) and a tie and cardigan or jumper. (available from Little Gems). Skirts and trouser must be grey. Blue gingham dresses are also acceptable in warm weather. Please ensure children are also wearing sensible school shoes. PE kits should consist of plain navy blue/black shorts and a plain t-shirt the colour of your child's school team, which will help us on Sport's Day. These can be purchased from Little Gems (or Amazon UK from as little as £2 each depending on the size). Please continue to use the plain blue ones if your child still has one which fits!
